

Division 4 Specs

- 8 and 9 year-olds
- Up to 14 players on roster
- 7 on the field which includes an assigned goalie who wears a different color shirt and can use hands.
- Game Interval 1 hour, 15 minutes
- 15 minute quarters (until the last quarter to keep games on time)
- Fast Fold Goals 5' high x 10' wide
- Field 175' x 85'

Division 4 Rules

- Referees whistle when ball goes out of bounds and then call the team and the action. (Blue throw in, Green corner kick, etc.) Referees use a flag to indicate direction.
 - Games 1 and 2: Referee demonstrates correct throw-in and gives a do-over if not done correctly.
 - Game 3 and beyond: Incorrect throw-in results in a turnover.
 - Referee enforces players on opposing team to back up to midfield on goal kicks.
 - Referee whistles hand balls and instructs on the rule.
 - Referees call fouls for inappropriate contact and award a free kick to the opposing team.
 - No Penalty kicks in Division 4.
 - Games 1 and 2: Coaches allowed to stand by their own goalie to keep them alert.
 - Game 3 and beyond: Coaches only coach from their own half of sidelines.
 - No headers allowed in Division 4.
 - Offsides is not called in Division 4.
- Coaches to discuss calls with referees at beginning of the game and at end of game
